heuristics for reduce on finding satisfactory balances in many cases. To apply to while perhaps general in some sense, these particular heuristic procedures transform into ideal are quite adapted to the task of line balancing. The other procedure in contrast to this one does not employ language but respect for the constraints by imposing arbitrary penalties for approaching any of the boundaries for the permissible region. PARSING SENTENCES AND QUANTITY OF MEANING

"Knowing more than one is told is a characteristic which is present in most behaviours which are called intelligent." The intelligence and understands the "meaning" of what it was told.

The meaningfulness of a word may be measured as the number of associations to that which a subject can produce in a given time.

EXPLICIT MEANING ABOVE MISTAKES

IMPLICIT EXTENSION, THIS SUGGESTION

The construction of a machine which understands explicit meaning requires the association of a number of expressions in such a manner that the machine will recognise each of the expressions as the same. In terms of an English machine which understands statements with definite, explicit meaning, the machine must recognise two sentences as "saying the same thing". For example it will arrange its system of internal storage so that the end result, whether "John is Joe's brother" or "It is not altered for different maps" encounter construct this property for a certain class of English sentences.

We wish to stipulate that our machine understand implicit meaning as well. We note that by re-mistaking the set of statements over which we mistake meaning may cast this situation as one of explicit meaning. Our last example becomes one of recognising the equivalence of these three statements.

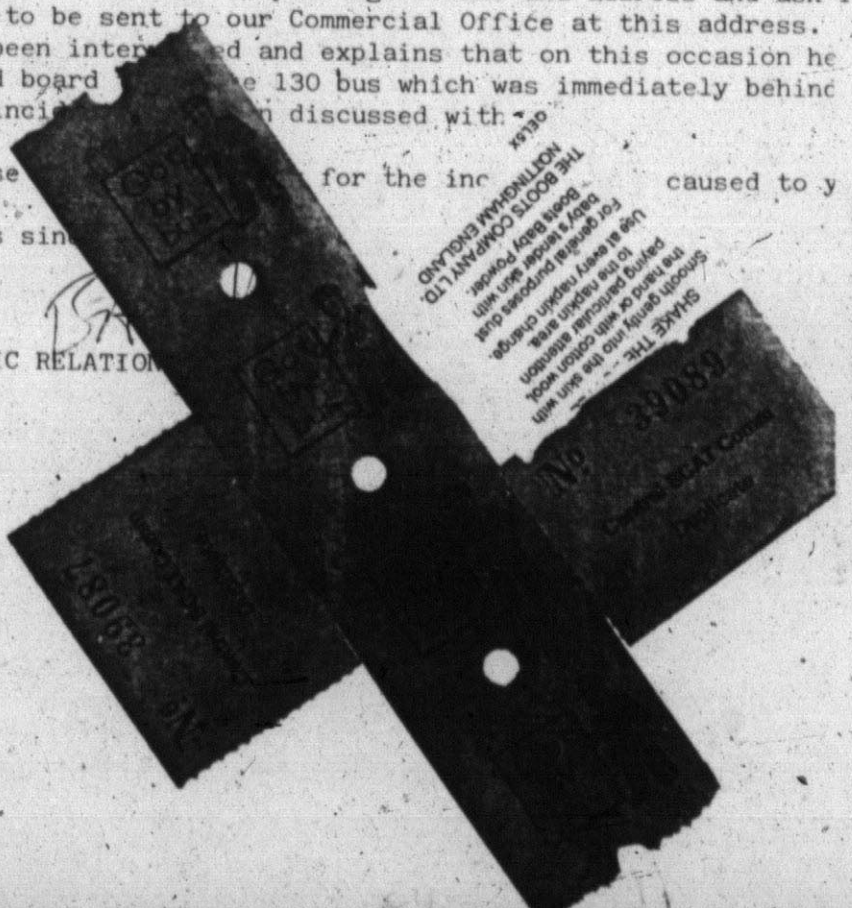
Thank you for your letter of the 17th regarding the difficulty you had that day when boarding a route C3 bus.

VIEWS ON STIMULATION AND A
LODEM OF SOCIAL SYSTEMS

A ("Have you never heard of sin swallowing")

Stimulation of a social system involves those features of the system which are deemed to be significant in the view of the objectives behind the stimulation.

The more obvious objectives of stimulation include:-

- ① Forecasting of macro-behaviour.
- ② Prediction of macro-consciousness of governmental actions.
- ③ Conducting of control and stabilizing studies.
- ④ Provision of aids to teaching and achievement.
- ⑤ Conducting of sensitivity studies as a source of research guidance.
- ⑥ Facilitating testing and estimation.

Stimulation is a very old approach. It may be a cumbersome approach and it seldom has the virtue of elegance. The generality may be approached but is not equalled. The cast of Lodem's and the carrying out of stimulations can be dissolving and largely deductive. Nevertheless the stimulation approach does have certain virtues which have led to its abuse in the past and will probably lead to the complete dominance of this approach.

Among other virtues stimulation can be understandable to persons with only modest sophistication. It is possible to arrange stimulations in such a way as to make it relatively easy to investigate the effects of varying parameters or initial conditions to new knowledge.

When each possible unit has been considered in this way, the first month is complete. We enter the second month with a population which is slightly different. Some individuals have died or married, some businesses or households have been created or destroyed, many have altered their asset and debt positions, or rather, have had them altered etc. The whole procedure is repeated ad-infinity. Every 12 months or so we take a census to see what we have left. This then is the real work of the general problem solver I.

PROBABALISTICS

Deterministic operating characteristics, advantageous from the standpoint of minimizing time. In some cases these considerations may outweigh others. Nevertheless with the development of faster and faster, with the development and use of expected techniques, it appears to us that probabalistic operating techniques are to be preferred.

A QUESTION OF CHRONOLOGY

ie. its not narrative, retelling, recounting, suggesting a sequence (not necessarily of related events), also in the sense of word events, syllable events etc, Jackson MacLow, before semantics rears its dappled raffer. This works on sentence, chapter, paragraph level also. Therefore language in its written word possesses a real or actual chronology as well as a semantic one.

The traditional concept of language as linear merely helps to exemplify the actual chronology of language is, one word follows another regardless of semantic tense etc; a word is present, past or future relative to its position in a narrative \Rightarrow an approximation of that arrangement in words, pictures, etc. This needs to be factual or accurate but need not have happened.

A point in the narrative is selected, this could be a word, a punctuation mark,

Something else ---, the only present moment of the narrative*, all else is either future, i.e. precedes the present point, or past, succeeds the present point. Given that a piece of writing may be said to exist at the moment/s it is read, the true temporal chronologic tense is present only when the piece is being read, i.e. multi-mode-chaining-of-associationed, the individual word is being read, all words preceding being past; all words succeeding being future, i.e. the reverse of the static temporal.

(* past being after the chosen point, future before it.)

chronology of writing, reading having a negative/positive relationship with writing, heterodoxy.

Given that we are only concerned with the temporal grammatics, not the surface semantics, it becomes obvious that since both imposed and inherent chronologies have only one element in common, i.e. the imposed or travelling temporal - chronologic present, it becomes undesirable to write in anything but the present, all other tenses being merely arbitrary indulgences, whims. The point may not be obvious. When reading or writing, all verbs should be presented/read in the present tense.

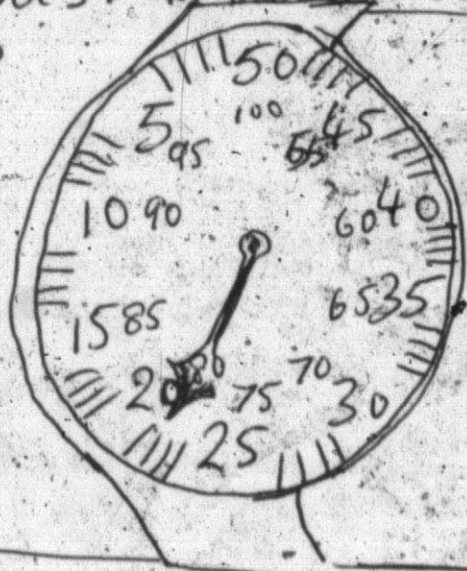



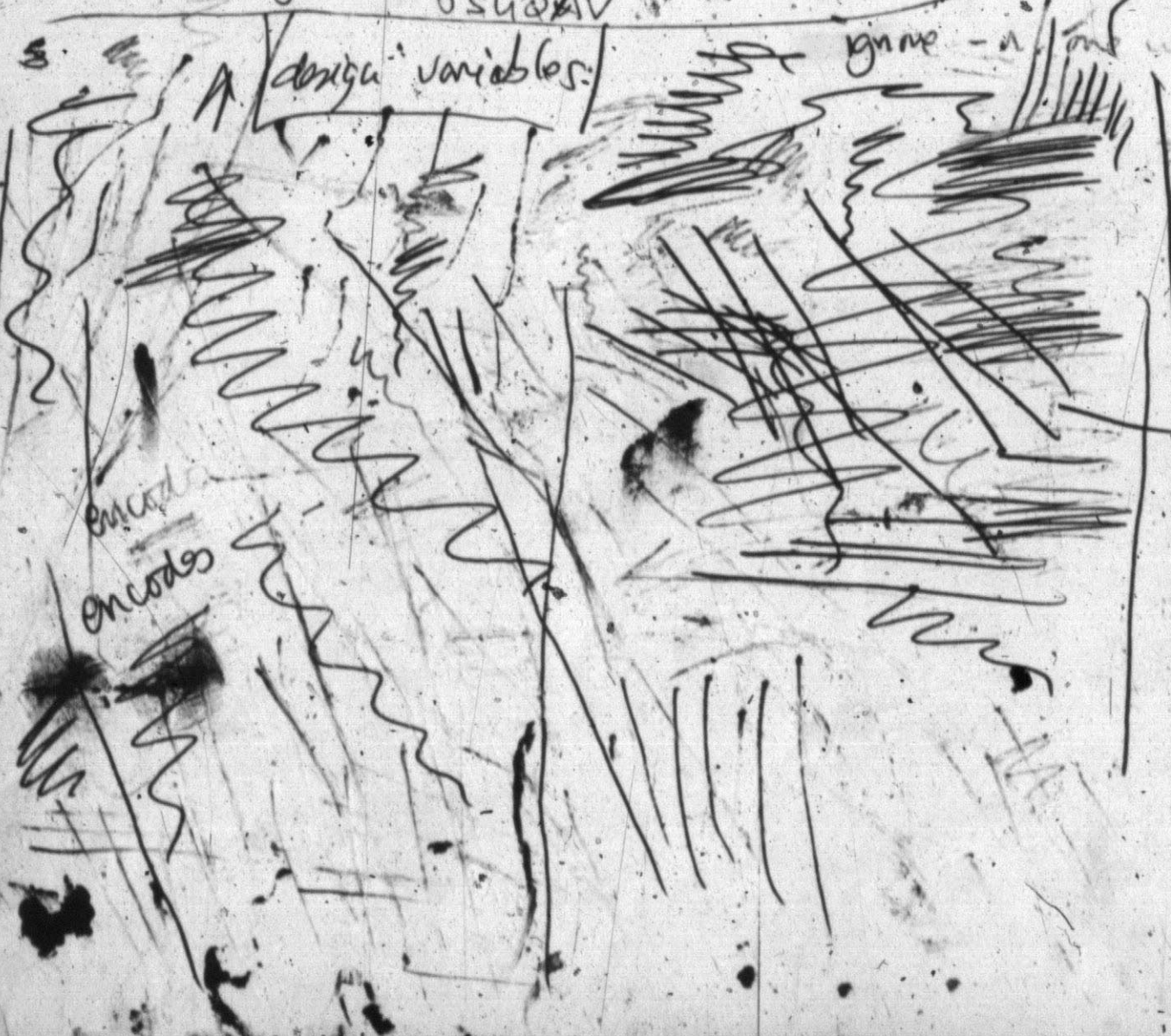
